## General - Entire House

□ Remove as much clutter as possible; store excess items in the garage.
$\square$ Replace any burned-out light bulbs and ensure color temperatures match in
multi-bulb fixtures.
□ Clean all windows, both inside and outside.
□ Remove or conceal personal items like family photos, paperwork, and bills.
□ Tidy and hide all power cords and cables.
□ Vacuum carpets and rugs; sweep hard surfaces.
□ Minimize items on tables and surfaces in every room.
□ Clean ceiling fans.
□ Store away any seasonal decorations.

<ul> <li>Put away all dishes, cutlery, and food items.</li> <li>Remove large or bulky countertop appliances.</li> <li>Clean the backsplash and range hood, particularly if they're stainless steel.</li> <li>Clear the sink and hide any detergents, dish cloths, and drying racks.</li> <li>Take down any pictures or magnets from the refrigerator.</li> <li>Remove pet bowls.</li> </ul>
Family/Living Room
<ul> <li>□ Store all remotes out of sight.</li> <li>□ Tidy up or remove all toys, fans, and game consoles.</li> <li>□ Straighten all cushions and pillows on couches</li> <li>□ Arrange DVDs, games, and books neatly on shelves.</li> <li>□ Eliminate stacks of magazines, paper, and mail.</li> </ul>
Dining Room
<ul><li>□ Straighten the dining chairs at the table.</li><li>□ Add a centerpiece or a small vase of flowers (keep it minimal).</li><li>□ Place settings are optional.</li></ul>
Bath Rooms
<ul> <li>□ Clean the tub and shower area, removing all soaps, shampoos, razors, etc.</li> <li>□ Clear counters of all toothbrushes, toothpaste, razors, hair dryers, and similar items.</li> <li>□ Ensure glass and mirrors are spotless.</li> <li>□ Remove all non-matching towels.</li> <li>□ Check that the toilet roll is not empty.</li> <li>□ Hide waste baskets and toilet cleaning tools (plunger and brushes).</li> </ul>
Bed Rooms
<ul> <li>□ Make the beds with coverings pulled tight and smoothed out.</li> <li>□ Arrange and fluff pillows neatly.</li> <li>□ Remove toys, books, games, and tissue boxes.</li> <li>□ Take away all personal items.</li> </ul>

<ul> <li>□ Ensure bedside lamps are in working order.</li> <li>□ Remove posters and stickers from the walls.</li> <li>□ Clear away all clothes and hampers.</li> </ul>
Outside Areas
<ul> <li>☐ Mow the lawn and trim the hedges.</li> <li>☐ Rake leaves and sweep walkways and the driveway.</li> <li>☐ Store away all gardening equipment, such as hoses, rakes, and wheelbarrows.</li> <li>☐ Remove weeds from prominent areas.</li> <li>☐ Straighten and arrange deck or patio furniture.</li> <li>☐ Clean up pet waste</li> </ul>
Pools & Spas
<ul> <li>□ Ensure the pool is clean and uncovered.</li> <li>□ Remove all pool cleaners and poles.</li> <li>□ Take away all pool toys.</li> <li>□ Keep the spa cover on.</li> </ul>
One Hour Before The Photo Session
<ul> <li>□ Close all windows.</li> <li>□ Open all window and door shades/blinds; if they're louvered, turn the blades horizontally.</li> <li>□ Turn on all interior lights.</li> <li>□ Turn on all exterior lights except for spotlights.</li> <li>□ Turn off ceiling fans.</li> <li>□ Turn off TVs and computer screens.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>□ Ensure all pets are out of sight; while I love pets, they shouldn't appear in any photos.</li> <li>□ Close all toilet lids.</li> <li>□ Remove all vehicles from the driveway and front of the home.</li> <li>□ Hide trash cans from street view.</li> <li>□ Close garage doors</li> </ul>
